Active in cultural diplomacy since 2006, he has spoken at UNESCO, the UK Parliament, and conferences in Jerusalem, Hebron, Istanbul, Ankara, Egypt, Jordan, India, Indonesia, Malaysia, Pakistan, as well as at Yale, Oxford, and the United Nations.

He received rabbinical ordination from Rabbi Amos Cherky and holds a B.Sc. in Cognitive Psychology with a minor in Linguistics. He lives in Israel with his wife, children, and grandchildren.

Rebecca Abrahamson is co-director of AlSadiqin.
